**Today's games are the pinnacle of the season for the juniors, and will no doubt be a showcase of the talent and teamwork that the top teams have displayed all year.**

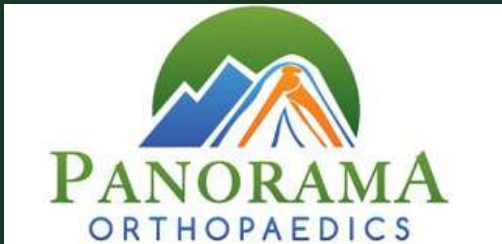

## BATHURST BUSHRANGERS

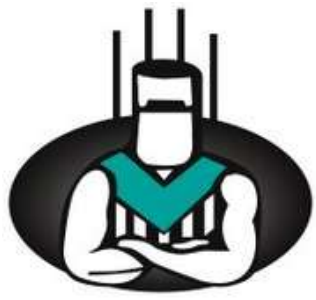
The Bushrangers youth girls have had a great season winning all bar one game so far but they know that means nothing without a victory today.
